

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XXXV OF 2002

THE SINDH CIVIL SERVANTS (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

[12TH October, 2002.]

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provincial Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Civil Servants (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 2002. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973 after section 23, the following new sections shall be inserted:-

“23A. **Indemnity** No suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall lie against a civil servant for anything done in his official capacity which is in good faith done or intended to be done under this Act or the rules, instructions or directions made or issued. **Insertion of section 23-A in Sindh Act XIV of 1973.**

23B. **Jurisdiction barred.** Save as provided under this Act and the Sindh Service Tribunals Act, 1973, or the rules made thereunder, no order made or proceedings taken under this Act, or the rules made thereunder by the Governor or any officer authorized by him shall be called in question in any Court and no injunction shall be granted by any Court in respect of any decision made, or proceedings taken in pursuance of any power conferred by, or under, this Act or the rules made thereunder.” **Insertion of section 23-B in Sindh Act XIV of 1973.**
