

SIND ORDINANCE NO. V of 1987.

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (THIRD AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1987.

[10th August, 1987]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government (Third Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 58, in sub-section (3), the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter, the following proviso shall be added:--

Amendment of section 58 of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.

“Provided that where the period of supersession of the council is expiring within four months of the expiry of its normal term of office, the council shall not be reconstituted for the residual period of the term and the consequences of supersession under sub-section (2) shall continue to operate.”.

(3) In the said Ordinance, in Schedule I, in entry 1, for the figures “202” the figures “204” shall be substituted.
