

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO. IV OF 2005.**  
**THE SINDH COTTON CONTROL**  
**(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2005.**

[May 20, 2005]

An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Cotton Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 2005.  
(2) It shall be come into force.
2. In the Sindh Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, in section 13-
  - (i) In sub-section (1), for the word "mark", the words "grade and staple length" shall be substituted; and
  - (ii) in sub-section(3), for the words "one month", the words "three months" and for the word "fifty", the words "ten thousand" shall be substituted.
