THE SIND GOVERNMENT EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING INSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1977.

SIND ORDINANCE NO. XII OF 1977

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Sind Government Educational and Training Institutions Ordinance, 1960.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Government Educational and Training Institutions Ordinance, 1960, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Government Educational and Training Institutions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the eighth day of March, 1973.

2. In the Sind Government Educational and Training Institutions Ordinance, 1960, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 3, for sub-section (1), the following shall be substituted:—

“(1) Government may by notification establish a Board of Governors for efficient management and control of one or more Institution.”.

3. In the said Ordinance, for section 4, the following shall be substituted:—

Constitution of the Board	“(4. (1) The Board shall consist of such number of official and non-official members not exceeding sixteen as may be appointed by Government.”
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(2) One of the members shall be appointed by Government to be the Chairman of the Board.

(3) An official member appointed by virtue of his office shall cease to be member on vacating such office.

(4) A non-official member shall hold office for a period of three years unless he resigns by addressing a letter to Government or is removed earlier.

(5) A member appointed in a casual vacancy shall hold office for the un-expired portion of the term.”.

4. In the said Ordinance, for section, 5, the following shall be substituted—

Re-Constitution of the Bosrd.	“(5. Government may at any time after establishment of the Board reconstitute such Board or remove any member before the expiry of the term of his office.”.
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Amendment
of section 6
of West
Pakistan
Ordinance XI
of 1960.

5. In the said Ordinance, for section 6, the following shall be substituted—

Secretary of the Bosrd.	“(6 (1) Government shall appoint any member or any other person as Secretary of the Board.”
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(2) The Secretary shall be entitled to such remuneration or other benefits as Government may determine.

(3) The Secretary shall exercise such powers as may from time to time be delegated by the Board.”.
