#### NOTIFICATION

Karachi, the 8th April, 1996

No. PAS/Legis-B-1/96.—The Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Bill, 1996 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 1st February, 1996 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 28th February, 1996 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

#### THE SINDH MINISTERS (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1996

#### SINDH ACT NO. VIII OF 1996

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sindh in the gazette of Sindh (Extra-Ordinary) Dated 8th April, 1996).

#### AN ACT

further to amend the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title  
and Commence-  
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1996.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Insertion of  
new section  
8-A in the  
Sindh Act  
VIII of 1975.

2. In the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act 1975:—

(i) after section 8, the following shall be inserted:—

“8-A, Custom duties or sales tax not leviable on Certain articles:—No custom duties or sales tax shall be levied on one car Mercedes Benz 280 SEL or equivalent for his personal use if imported or purchase out of bond by the Chief Minister on his appointment or during his tenure of office”.

(ii) the existing section 8-A shall be re-numbered as section 8-AA.

Repeal.

3. The Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996, is hereby repealed.
