Karachi, the 13th March, 1996

No. PAS/Legis-B-2/96.—The Sindh Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Bill, 1996 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 4th February, 1996 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 25th February, 1996 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

SINDH ACT NO. VII OF 1996

AN

ACT

to amend the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act 1974

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1974, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1996.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Section 3 of Sind Act XXIV of 1974

2. In the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1974, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for section 3, the following shall be substituted:—

“3. Salary and Privilage

A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to-

- (i) a salary of ten thousand one hundred and ninety rupees per month; and
- (ii) an orderly allowance of one thousand rupees per month upto and inclusive of 31st August, 1995 and one thousand and six hundred rupees per month with effect from 1st September, 1995.
- (iii) the use of an official car of 1300 cc (indigenously manufactured) with a Driver maintained at Government expense.”

Amendment of Section 4-A of Sind Act XXIV of 1974.

3. In the said Act, in section 4-A, in sub-section (2), for the words “one thousand five hundred per month”, the words “forty-five percent of the minimum of BS-21 as admissible in 1991”, shall be substituted.

Amendment of Section 4-B of Sind Act XXIV of 1974.

4. In section 4-B, for clause (ii), the following shall be substituted:—

- “(ii) telephone facilities at residence and office at Government expense at the same scale as is admissible to an officer of BS-21.”

5. In the said Act, in section 4-D, for the words "a member of the Assembly", the words "an officer of BS-21" shall be substituted. Amendment of Section 4-D of Sind Act XXIV of 1974
6. In the said Act, after section 4-D, the following shall be added:— Addition of Section 4-E of Sind Act XXIV of 1974
- "4-E Medical Reimbursement" A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to the medical facilities as admissible to an officer of BS-21".
7. In the said Act, section 5 shall be deleted. Deletion of section 5 of Sind Act XXIV of 1974
