**THE SINDH LAND TAX AND AGRICULTURAL INCOME TAX
(SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.**

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XX of 2002.

**AN
ORDINANCE**

to amend the Sindh Land Tax and Agricultural Income Tax Ordinance, 2000

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Land Tax and Agricultural Income Tax Ordinance, 2000, in the manner hereinafter appearing

AND WHEREAS her Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the emergency (No. 1) and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999;

AND WHEREAS the Government of Sindh is satisfied that a crisis situation exists which renders it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW THEREFORE in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order and with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999 and an exercise of all powers enabling it in that behalf the Government of Sindh as pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Land Tax and Agricultural Income Tax (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

2. It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect from 1st June, 2002.

3. In the Sindh Land Tax and Agricultural Income Tax Ordinance, 1997 in the First Schedule for clause (a) the following shall be substituted:

- (i) Married Couple
- (ii) Married Benifit
- (iii) Unmarried
- (iv) Unmarried

RRs. 500 per acre per annum

RRs. 250 per acre per annum
