SIND ORDINANCE No. I of 1984

AN

ORDINANCE

*to amend the Court-fees Act, 1870*  
in its application to the Province of Sind.

Preamble

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Court-fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

(1) This Ordinance may be called the Court-fees (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Court-fees Act, 1870, hereinafter referred to as the said Act in its application to the Province of Sind, section 19-A, 19B, 19E, 19-F, 19-G, 19-H, 19-I, and 19-J shall be omitted.

Omission of certain sections

3. In the said Act, in the First Schedule, Articles 9, 10 and 13 shall be omitted.

4. In the said Act, in the Second Schedule after Article 13, the following new Article shall be inserted:—

“13A. (a) Probate of a will or letters of administration with or without will annexed.

(b) Certificate under Part X of the Succession Act, 1925.

(c) Certificate under the Sind Regulation VIII of 1827”.
