Sind Ordinance No. VII of 1984.

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897,

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain Preamble amendments in the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Reformatory Schools (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897, in its application to the Province of Sind, in section 17, in sub-section (2), the comma and the words "of whom two at least shall be citizens of Pakistan" shall be deleted. Amendment of section 17 of Act VIII of 1897
