THE SIND MILK BOARDS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984.

Sindh Ordinance No. XVI of 1984.

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Sind Milk Boards Ordinance, 1963.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain Preamble, amendments in the Sind Milk Boards Ordinance, 1963;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Milk Boards Ordinance 1963, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Milk Boards (Amend-
ment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment
of section 33
of West
Pakistan
Ordinance
XXXVIII of
1963.

2. In the Sind Milk Boards Ordinance, 1963, in section 33, after sub-
section (1), the following sub-section (1-A) shall be inserted:—

“(1-A) Where any such suit is instituted Without leaving or
delivering such notice as aforesaid or before the expiration of the
said period of two months, or where the plaint does not contain
a statement that such notice has been so left or delivered, the
plaintiff shall not be entitled to any costs if settlement as regards
the subject-matter of the suit is reached or the Board or any
person referred to in sub-section (1), concedes the plaintiff’s claim,
within the period of two months from the date of the institution
of the suit:

Provided that in a suit instituted without such notice the
court shall allow not less than three months to the Board to
submit its written statement.”
