AN

ORDINANCE

*to amend the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control)
Ordinance, 1970.*

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the law relating to management and control of private colleges: Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) Ordinance, 1970, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title
and

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment
of section 5
of Sind
Ordinance X
of 1970.

2. In the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) Ordinance, 1970, in section 5, after sub-section (1), the following new sub-section shall be inserted:—

“(1-A) The Chairman or a member may be removed from office for such reasons and in such manner as may be prescribed:

Provided that no order of removal shall be passed unless the Chairman or member, as the case may be, is given an opportunity of being heard.”.
