SIND ORDINANCE No. XXIV of 1984.

AN

ORDINANCE

to repeal the Sind Horse Race Betting Tax Act, 1958.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has advised the Provincial Preamble. Government to consider the advisability of retaining the Sind Horse Race Betting Tax Act, 1958, on the Statute Book in view of the complete ban on horse race betting:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Sind Horse Race Betting Tax Act, 1958;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Horse Race Betting Tax (Repeal) Ordinance, 1984.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Repeal of West Pakistan Act IV of 1958. 2. The Sind Horse Race Betting Tax Act, 1958, is hereby repealed.
