SIND ORDINANCE NO. XL OF 1984

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Sind Civil Servants Act, 1973.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Civil Servants Act, 1973, Preamble, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Civil Servants (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment
of section 5
of Sind Act
XIV of 1973.

2. (2) In the Sind Civil Servants Act, 1973, in section 5, the full-stop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:—

“Provided that one per centum of such appointments shall, subject to availability, be made from amongst the disabled persons as defined in the Disabled Persons, (Employment and Rehabilitation) Ordinance, 1981.”.
