THE SOCIETIES REGISTRATION (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984.

SIND ORDINANCE NO. XLI OF 1984.

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Societies Registration Act, 1860, in its application to the Province of Sindh.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the Societies Registration Act, 1860, in its application to the Province of Sindh; Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Societies Registration Act, 1860, in its application to the Province of Sindh, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Societies Registration (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at-once.

Amendment
of section
16-A of Sind
Act XXI of
1860.

2. In the Societies Registration Act, 1860, in its application to the province of Sind, in section 16-A, in sub-section (1), the fullstop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:—

“Provided that no governing body shall be superseded unless it is given an opportunity of being heard.”
