No. S. Legis. 1(3)/83.—The following Ordinance by the Governor of Sindh is hereby published for general information:—

THE SIND MINISTERS (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT, 1975.

SIND ORDINANCE NO. III OF 1983.

AN

ORDINANCE

*to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1983. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 1st January, 1983.

Insertion of section 3-A in Sind Act VIII of 1975.

2. In the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, after section 3, the following shall be inserted:—

✓“3-A. A Minister shall, on his first appointment, be entitled to Equipment Allowance. | equipment allowance of three thousand rupees.” ✓

Amendment of section 5 of Sind Act VIII of 1975.

3. In the said Act, in section 5, for the words “shall respectively be three thousand rupees and two thousand five hundred rupees per mensem” the words ✓shall be three thousand rupees per mensem” ✓shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 6 of Sind Act VIII of 1975.

4. In the said Act, in section 6, for the words “one thousand rupees” the words ✓one thousand and five hundred rupees” ✓shall be substituted.

Insertion of section 6-A in Sind Act VIII of 1975.

5. In the said Act, after section 6, the following shall be inserted:—

✓“6-A. A Minister may in his discretion make grants to the Discretionary Grant. | extent of seven thousand and five hundred rupees in a year.” ✓

Amendment of section 7 of Sind Act VIII of 1975.

6. In the said Act, in section 7—

(i) in sub-section (1), for the words “shall be provided with official residence” the words ✓shall be provided with free furnished official residence” shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-section (3), in clause (a), for the words “thirty thousand rupees” the words “forty thousand rupees” shall be substituted.

Insertion of section 8-A in Sind Act VIII of 1975.

7. In the said Act, after section 8, the following shall be inserted:—

✓“8-A. A Minister shall be entitled to telephone facilities at his Telephone. | office and residence at Government expense without ceiling.”.

Amendment of section 16 of Sind Act VIII of 1975.

8. In the said Act, the existing section 16 shall be renumbered as sub-section (1) of that section and thereafter the following shall be added:—

“(2) A Minister shall be entitled to receive leave salary of three thousand rupees per mensem.”.
