No. PAS/Legis-B-6/85.—The Co-operative Housing Authority (Amendment) Bill, 1985 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 20th October, 1985 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 31st October 1985 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

THE CO-OPERATIVE HOUSING AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ACT 1985.

SIND ACT NO. IV OF 1985

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra-Ordinary) dated 12th December, 1985).

AN

ACT

to amend the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority (Amendment) Act, 1985. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 24th September, 1985.

2. In the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 14 —

(i) in sub-section (1), for the words "six months" the words "one year" shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-section (2), for the words "one year", the words "two years" shall be substituted.

3. In the said Ordinance, after section 14, the following section 14-A shall be inserted:—

"14-A Eligibility to election

Except with the permission of Government, no person who was an office bearer in a society immediately before its taking over under section 6 shall be eligible to contest election under sub-section (1) of section 14."
