**THE SINDH AGRICULTURAL SUPPLIES ORGANIZATION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1981.**

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. II OF 1981.

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Sindh Agricultural Supplies Organization Act, 1973.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Agricultural Supplies Organization Act, 1973, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Agricultural Supplies Organization (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981. Short Title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Agricultural Supplies Organization Act, 1973, for section 5, the following shall be substituted:— Amendment of section 5 of Sindh Act X of 1973.

“5. (1) The Board shall consist of such official and non-official members not exceeding seven as may be appointed by Government; provided that the Operational Director appointed under sub-section (2)

shall be one of the official members.

(2) Government shall appoint Operational Director on such terms and conditions as it deems fit and he shall be responsible for—

- (i) all administrative matters of the Organization subject to the directions of the Board;
- (ii) procurement, handling and distribution of the improved seeds and fertilizers under section 12;
- (iii) maintenance of proper accounts; and
- (iv) performance of such other duties as may be necessary for the purposes of this Act or which may be prescribed.”
