### PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF SIND NOTIFICATION

Karachi, the 9th November, 1974.

No. PAS/Legis/Bill-16/74.—The Sind Court of Wards (Amendment) Bill, 1974 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 5th November, 1974 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 9th November, 1974 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

#### THE SIND COURT OF WARDS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1974.

SIND ACT NO. XIX OF 1974.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary), dated 9th November, 1974).

ACT

*to amend the Sind Court of Wards Act, 1905.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Court of Wards Act, Preamble, 1905, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title  
and commen-  
cement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Court of Wards (Amendment) Act, 1974.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment  
of section 4  
of Sind Act  
I of 1905.

2. In the Sind Court of Wards Act, 1905, in section 4, in sub-section (1), for the existing proviso, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Provided that in the case of a land-holder or pension-holder disqualified under clause (b) or (c) of sub-section (1) of section 5 such assumption shall be sanctioned only where the Provincial Government is of opinion that it is expedient in the public interest to preserve the property of such land-holder or pension-holder for the benefit of his family, and that the said property is of such value that economical management by the Court of Wards is practicable.”
