No. PAS/Legis/Bill-25/74.—The West Pakistan Motor Vehicles (Sind Amendment) Bill, 1974 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 6th November, 1974 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 11th November, 1974 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

THE WEST PAKISTAN MOTOR VEHICLES (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1974.

SIND ACT No. XX OF 1974.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary), dated 12th November, 1974).

AN

ACT

to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles (Sind Amendment) Act, 1974.

2. In the West Pakistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, the note at the end of the Sixth Schedule shall be numbered as "Note 1", and the following shall be added as note 2:—

"Note: 2. In the case of Karachi District when all the series from 'A' to 'Z' under note 1 are exhausted, new group of letters shall be used as the registration mark in the following orders:—

KCC for private cars.

KCJ for jeeps.

KCS for station wagons and other similar vehicles.

KCB for buses.

KCT for trucks.

KCX for taxis.

KCY for scooters and motorcycles.

KCR for motorcycle rickshaws.

KCM for miscellaneous vehicles (tractors/cranes)."
