Karachi, the 26th November, 1974.

No. PAS/Legis/Bill-29/74.—The Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Bill, 1974 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 13th November, 1974 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 18th November, 1974 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

SIND PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT, 1974.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary), dated 26th November 1974).

to provide for the salaries, allowances and privileges of the Parliamentary Secretaries.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the salaries, allowances and privileges of the Parliamentary Secretaries; Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1974. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Definitions.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say—

- (a) "Assembly" means the Provincial Assembly of Sind;
- (b) "Parliamentary Secretary" means the Parliamentary Secretary appointed as such by the Chief Minister;
- (c) "Session" means the period commencing from the date of the first sitting of the Assembly, after it has been summoned, and ending on its prorogation or dissolution.

Salary.

3. A Parliamentary Secretary shall, inclusive of his salary as member of the Assembly, be entitled to a salary of one thousand and five hundred rupees per month.

Daily Allowance.

4. A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to a daily allowance of one hundred rupees per day for two days immediately before and two days after the Session and rupees Seventyfive per day during such Session.

Explanation.—Not more than one daily allowance shall be admissible for a single day.

Other Allowances and privileges.

5. Subject to the provisions of this Act, a Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to all allowances including travelling allowance and privileges admissible to a member of the Assembly.
