No. PAS/Legis-B-29/72.—The Provincial Assembly of Sind (Amendment) Bill, 1972 having been passed by the Provincial Assen. Sind on the 23rd December, 1972 and assented to by the Governor Sind on the 28th December, 1972 is hereby published as an Act of Legislature of Sind:—

THE PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF SIND PRIVILEGES
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1972.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary) dated the 28th December, 1972).

AN

ACT

to amend the Provincial Assembly of Sind Privileges Act, 1972.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Provincial Assembly of Sind Privileges Act, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Provincial Assembly of Sind Privileges (Amendment) Act, 1972.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

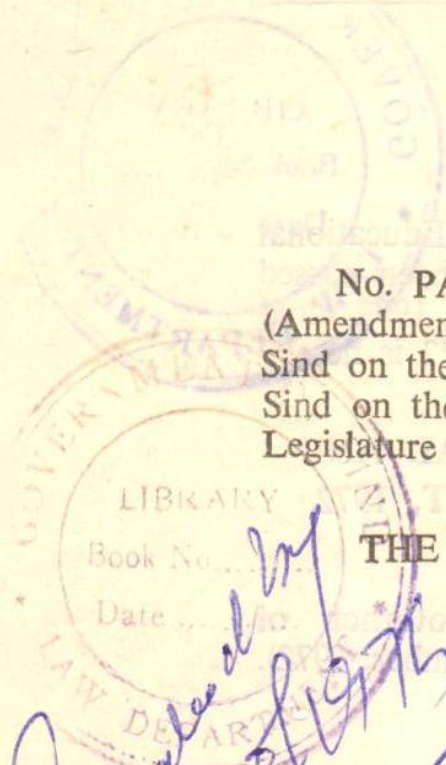
Insertion of sections 8-A and 8-B in Sind Act VI of 1972.

2. In the Provincial Assembly of Sind Privileges Act, 1972, after section 8, the following new sections shall be inserted, namely:—

Members to be V.I.Ps.

“8-A. The Members shall be V.I.Ps. and be entitled to all privileges admissible to V.I.Ps., under any law for the time being in force or any instructions issued by Government or the Central Government.

Accommodation in Circuit houses, etc. 8-B. A Member shall, on prior intimation to the authority concerned and subject to the availability of accommodation, be entitled to accommodation in a circuit house, rest house or dak bungalow maintained by Government or any local authority, on payment of such amount as is charged from a touring officer while on duty for accommodation in such circuit house, rest house or dak bungalow, as the case may be.

Visit to Institutions in his own district 8-C. A Member shall be entitled to visit hospitals, educational and other Government Institutions located within his district with previous intimation. After such visit the Member house, rest house or dak bungalow, as the case may be.
