SIND ACT No. XIII OF 1953¹.

[THE SIND LOCAL BOARDS (CANCELLATION OF NOMINATION)

ACT, 1953.]

An Act to cancel the nomination of candidates made during the period between 28th November, 1952 and 2nd March, 1953 for election to fill the seats of members of district local boards in the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to cancel the nomination of candidates made during the period between 28th November 1952, and 2nd March 1953 for election to fill the seats of members of district local boards in the Province of Sind; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Local Boards (Cancellation of Nomination) Act, 1953.

Short title, extent and commencement.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Province of Sind.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Notwithstanding anything in the Sind Local Boards Act, 1923, or any other law for the time being in force, or any judgment, decree or order of any court to the contrary the nominations of all candidates made during the period between 28th November, 1952 and 2nd March, 1953 for election to fill the seats of members of district local boards in the Province of Sind, are hereby cancelled and any right or privilege that may have accrued to any person on account of his having been nominated, and if he was the only candidate nominated to fill any seat, of his having been declared elected to fill any seat, shall be extinguished and have no effect.

Cancellation of nomination.

3. No suit or other legal proceedings shall lie against the Provincial Government, or any person or authority for any loss or damage of any kind whatsoever caused by the cancellation of any nomination under the preceding section.

Bar of suits.
