

[THE SIND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (SPEAKER'S AND DEPUTY
SPEAKER'S SALARIES ACT, 1937.)*Repealed by S. P. Act 11 of 1952*

[17th June, 1937]

*An Act to determine the salary of the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker
of the Sind Legislative Assembly.*

WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section (4) of section 65 of the Government of India Act, 1935, that the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker of a Legislative Assembly shall be paid such salaries as may be respectively fixed by Act of the Provincial Legislature; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Sind Legislative Assembly ^{Short title,}
(Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's Salaries) Act, 1937.

2. (1) There shall be paid to the Speaker of the Sind Legislative ^{salary of}
Assembly a salary at the rate of ²[two thousand and five hun- ^{the Speaker,}
dred rupees] per mensem ³[and a General Allowance at the rate of
four hundred rupees per mensem].

(2) The Speaker shall not, during his tenure of that office, practise any profession or engage in any trade or undertake for remuneration any employment other than his duties as Speaker of the Sind Legislative Assembly.

Legislative Assembly a salary at the rate of five hundred rupees ^{Deputy}
