## SIND ACT No. III OF 19371.

[THE SIND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (REMOVAL OF DISQUALIFICATIONS) ACT, 1937.]

[17th June, 1937]

An Act to provide for the removal of certain disqualifications for elections to the Sind Legislative Assembly.

Whereas it is expedient to provide in accordance with clause (a) of sub-section (r) of section 69 of the Government of India Act, 1935, that the holders of \*[offices] hereinafter appearing shall not be disqualified for election to the Sind Legislative Assembly; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- I. This Act may be called the Sind Legislative Assembly Short title. (Removal of Disqualifications) Act, 1937.
- 2. A person shall not be disqualified for being chosen as, or Removal of for being a member of the Sind Legislative Assembly by reason eartain disonly of the fact that he holds <sup>3</sup>[any office of profit under the Crown tions.
