SIND ORDINANCE NO. XII OF 1971.

AN

ORDINANCE

to validate octroi tax charged, collected or realised by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to validate the octroi tax charged, collected or realised by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh and

Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D', is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be called the Sind (Town Committee, Bhirya Road) Validation of Octroi Tax Ordinance, 1971.

Validation of Octroi Tax charged, collected or realised from 24-3-1966 to 24-8-1970.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the West Pakistan Local Councils (Imposition of Taxes) Rules, 1961, or any other law for the time being in force, the octroi tax charged, collected or realised by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah on and from 24th March 1966 to 24th August, 1970 without the sanction of the Commissioner, Khairpur Division, under rule 7 of the said rules, shall be deemed to have been validly charged, collected or realised, as the case may be.
