

**SIND ORDINANCE NO. IV OF 1970**

**THE WEST PAKISTAN HORSE – RACE BETTING TAX (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1970**

[25<sup>th</sup> August, 1970]

**An Ordinance** to amend the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25<sup>th</sup> March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1970. **Short title,**

2. In the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in clause (F) of section 2, sub-section (1) of section 8 and sub-section (2), (3) and (4) section 10, for the word "Commissioner", wherever occurring, the words and commas "Director-General, Excise and Taxation," Shall be substituted. **Amendment of sections 2, 8 and 10 of W.P. Act IV of 1958.**
