**NO.PAS/Legis-B-29/2012-** The Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute Bill, 2012 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2013 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

**THE KARACHI SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND

**SINDH ACT NO. XV OF 2013.**

**AN  
ACT**

to provide for the establishment of the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to provide for the establishment of the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute and to provide for matters ancillary thereto; **Preamble.**

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute Act, 2012.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

**Definition.**

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context -

- (a) "Academic Council" means the Academic Council of the Institute;
- (b) "Authority" means any Authority of the Institute as specified in section 7;
- (c) "Board" means the Board of Governors of the Institute;
- (d) "Chairman" means Chairman of the Board;
- (e) "Commission" means the Higher Education Commission;
- (f) "Dean" means the Dean of a Faculty;
- (g) "Faculty" means the Faculty of the Institute;
- (h) "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
- (i) "Head" means head of a Teaching Department;
- (j) "Institute" means the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute;
- (k) "Patron" means the Patron of the Institute;
- (l) "prescribed" means prescribed by statutes, regulations and rules;
- (m) "Rector" means the Rector of the Institute;
- (n) "Registrar" means the Registrar of the Institute;
- (o) "Sponsor" means the Karachi Education Initiative, a non-profit company limited by guarantee incorporated under section 42 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984;
- (p) "statutes, regulations and rules" means the statutes, regulations and rules respectively made under this Act;
- (q) "teacher" means whole time teacher engaged as Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor and Lecturer and such person as may be declared to be the teacher by regulations;
- (r) "Teaching Department" means the Teaching Department established and maintained by the Institute.

3. (1) There shall be established at Karachi, an Institute to be called the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute consisting of -

- (i) the members of such council, committees and other bodies as the Board may establish;
- (ii) the teachers and students of the Institute and its constituent units;
- (iii) the Chairman, the Rector, the Deans and other members of the Board; and
- (iv) such other officers and members of the staff as may from time to time be specified by the Board.

(2) The Institute shall be a body corporate by the name of the Karachi School of Business and Leadership Institute, having perpetual succession and a common seal, with power, amongst others to acquire, hold and dispose of any property or investments and shall by the said name sue and be sued.

(3) The Institute may take measures to setup campus or campuses throughout the country.

4. The powers and functions of the Institute are subject to this Act and such instructions as may be prescribed by Government from time to time. The Institute shall have the powers to -

- (a) provide for instructions in such branches of learning as it may deem fit, and to make provision for research, demonstration and other services for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge in such manner as it may determine; provided that the faculty of medicine shall be established as per requirement of the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council;
- (b) admit and examine students;
- (c) establish, maintain and administer any faculty, teaching department, business, administrative unit of the Institute;
- (d) hold examinations and to award and confer degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions on and to the persons who have been admitted to and have passed its examinations under prescribed conditions;
- (e) appoint such officers and staff and prescribe terms and conditions and powers and duties of such officers and staff;
