No. PAS/Legis-B-15/94.—The Sindh Civil Servants (Regularization of Adhoc Appointments) Bill, 1994 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 15th June, 1994 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 18th July, 1994 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

*to provide for regularization of the services of certain civil servants
appointed on adhoc basis.*

WHEREAS it is expedient in the public interest to provide for regularization of the services of certain civil servants appointed on adhoc basis in the manner hereinafter appearing: Preamble

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title
and commen-
cement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Civil Servants (Regulation of Adhoc Appointments) Act, 1994.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Definitions

2. (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

(a) "Act" means the Sindh Civil Servants Act 1973;

(b) "Commission" means the Sindh Public Service Commission;

(c) "Government" means the Government of Sindh; and

(d) "post" means a post sanctioned by Government concerned with the affairs of the Province.

(2) The expressions "adhoc appointment" and "civil servant" shall have the same meanings as respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or rules made thereunder, or in any decree, order or judgement of a court, but subject to the provisions of this Act a civil servant holding adhoc appointment against a post in BS-16 or above and is in employment on the commencement of this Act, shall, on orders made in that behalf, be deemed to have been validly appointed to that post on regular basis with effect from the date of the commencement of this Act.

(2) The orders under sub-section (1) shall not be made unless the antecedents of such civil servant, his academic qualifications, experience and place of domicile are scrutinized and cleared by a Special Committee appointed by Government.

(3) The Special Committee under sub-section (2) shall be headed by the Secretary incharge of the Department concerned and amongst others shall consist of a representative each from that Department and the Services and General Administration Department.

4. Where the Commission, has recommended any person for appointment to a post in a cadre or service before the commencement of this Act such person may be accommodated
