THE WEST PAKISTAN HORSE – RACE BETTING TAX (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1970

[25th August, 1970]

An Ordinance to amend the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1970. **Short title,**

2. In the West Pakistan Horse-race Betting Tax Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in clause (F) of section 2, sub-section (1) of section 8 and sub-section (2), (3) and (4) section 10, for the word "Commissioner", wherever occurring, the words and commas "Director-General, Excise and Taxation," Shall be substituted. **Amendment of sections 2, 8 and 10 of W.P. Act IV of 1958.**
