

THE SIND ABKARI ACT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1970

[27th October, 1970]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Abkari Act (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970. **Short title and commencement.**
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. In the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 44, for the words "two hundred rupees", the words "one thousand rupees" shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 44 of Sind Act V of 1878.**
3. In section 45 of the said Act, for the words "three months or with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees or with both", the words and commas "one year, or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees, or with both" shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 45 of Sind Act V of 1878.**
4. In section 45A of the said Act, for the words "two hundred rupees", the words "one thousand rupees" shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 45A of Sind Act V of 1878.**
5. In section 46 of the said Act, for the words and commas "five hundred rupees, or with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months, or with both" the words and commas "one thousand rupees, or with imprisonment which may extend to one year, or with both" shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 46 of Sind Act V of 1878.**
6. In section 55A of the said Act, for the words "two hundred rupees", the words "one thousand rupees" shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 55A of Sind Act V of 1878.**
