An Ordinance to validate octroi tax charged, collected or realized by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to validate octroi tax charged, collected or realized by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah; **Preamble.**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25<sup>th</sup> March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind and Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D', is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. This Ordinance may be called the Sind (Town Committee, Bhirya Road) Validation of Octroi Tax Ordinance, 1971. **Short title.**

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the West Pakistan Local Councils (Imposition of Taxes) Rules, 1961, or any other law for the time being in force, the octroi tax charged, collected or realized by the Town Committee, Bhirya Road, District Nawabshah on and from 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1966 to 24<sup>th</sup> August, 1970 without the sanction of the Commissioner, Khairpur Division, under rule 7 of the said rules, shall be deemed to have been validly charged, collected or realized, as the case may be.
