

**THE SIND ORDINANCE NO. I OF 1972**  
**THE SIND SPECIAL TRIBUNAL (REPEAL) ORDINANCE, 1972.**

[14<sup>th</sup> February, 1972]

An Ordinance to repeal the Sind Special Tribunal Ordinance, 1970.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to repeal the Sind Special Tribunal Ordinance, 1970. **Preamble.**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25<sup>th</sup> March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind and Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D', is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :---

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Special Tribunal (Repeal) Ordinance, 1972. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force on and from the 15<sup>th</sup> February, 1972.

2. (1) The Sindh Special Tribunal Ordinance, 1972, is hereby repealed. **Repeal of Sind Ordinance III of 1970.**

(2) The repeal of the Sind Special Tribunal Ordinance, 1970, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, by this Ordinance shall not, subject to the provisions of sub-section (3), affect---

(a) the previous operation of the Principal Ordinance, or anything duly done or suffered thereunder; or

(b) any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred thereunder; or

(c) any legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid, and any such legal proceeding or

remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced, as if the Principal Ordinance had not been repealed.

(3) All the cases pending before the said Tribunal, immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance shall stand transferred to the Court of Special Judge having jurisdiction and be heard and disposed of by it as if these cases had been originally instituted in the said Court.
