

SIND ORDINANCE NO. IX OF 1972

THE LAND CONTROL (KARACHI DIVISION) (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1972

[10th June, 1972]

An Ordinance to amend the Land Control (Karachi Division) Act, 1952, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Land Control (Karachi Division) Act, 1952, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of Sind is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate action necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by clause (1) of Article 135 of the Interim Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Land Control (Karachi Division) (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Land Control (Karachi Division) Act, 1952, in its application to the Province of Sind, after section 19, the following new section shall be added, namely:-

Addition of section 19-A to Act XI of 1952.

Requisition of police assistance.

“19-A.If the Authorised Officer requires police assistance in the exercise of his powers under this Act, he may send a requisition to the officer incharge of a police station who shall on such requisition render the required assistance.”.
