## THE FOREST (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1972

[30<sup>th</sup> October, 1972]

An Ordinance to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of Sind.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in **Preamble** its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate action necessary;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of the powers conferred on him by clause (1) of Article 135 of the Interim Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1)	This	Ordinance	may	be	called	the	Forest	(Sind	Short title and
	Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.							-	commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Amendment of Province of Sind, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 67, for the words, "Magistrate of the first class", the words "Special Executive Magistrate" shall be substituted.

3. In the said Act, in section 68, for sub-section (3), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:-- of 1927.

"(3) A Forest officer shall not be empowered under this section unless he is a Forest-officer of a rank no inferior to that of a Ranger, and the sum of money accepted as compensation under clause (a) of sub-section (1) shall in no case exceed the sum of five hundred rupees.".

4. In the said Act, for the cattles and amount of fines Amendment of mentioned in section 71, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"For each elephant	•••••	Fifty rupees.
For each Camel	••••	Forty rupees.
For each Buffalo		Twenty-five rupees.

For each horse, mare, gelding, pony, colt, filly, mule, bull, bullock, cow, or heifer ......

Fifteen rupees.

For each calf, ass, pig, ram ewe, sheep, lamb goat or kid. ......

Ten rupees.".

5. In the said Act, after section 79, the following new section shall be added, namely:-- Addition of section 1927

"79-A, If any Forest-officer authorized to take Requisition of police action under this Act requires police assistance in the exercise of his powers thereunder he may send requisition to the officer in charge of a police station who shall on such requisition render the assistance required.".
