SIND ACT NO.XXVII OF 1974

THE SIND (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) ACT, 1974

[11th December, 1974]

An Act to amend certain laws applicable to the Province of Sind, for conferring powers on Commissioners.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend certain laws applicable to the Province of Sind, for conferring powers on Commissioners in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

It is hereby enacted as follows:--

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind (Amendment of Laws) Act, 1974. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. The Acts and Ordinances specified in the Schedule shall stand amended in the manner indicated in the fourth column thereof, and, save as expressly provided, the rules, regulations, bye-laws, notifications and orders made or issued thereunder shall be construed accordingly. **Amendments.**

3. Any appeal, review or revision petition or any other case pending before the Revenue Commissioner immediately before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall stand transferred to and be disposed of by the Commissioner having jurisdiction. **Transfer of appeals, etc.**

4. A Commissioner may— **Inspection of projects.**

(i) visit or inspect any project sponsored, under the Annual Development Programme or by any local authority and make a report to Government;

(ii) call for any information, report or record relating to such project from the officer incharge thereof within the Division.

Explanation.—The power under this section shall not entitle the Commissioner to give any direction or orders involving administrative or financial implications.

6. The Sind (Amendment of Laws) Ordinance, 1974, is hereby repealed. **Repeal of Sindh Ordinance XVII of 1974.**

(1) The Authority shall, immediately after any housing scheme is sanctioned by, or altered with approval of, Government, submit to the Commissioner the details including the survey numbers, area and location of each plot reserved for roads, hospitals, schools, colleges, libraries, play grounds, gardens, parks, community centres, mosques, grave yards or such other purpose and the Commissioner shall notify such details in the official Gazette.

(2) The Authority or the Housing Society may at any time prior to utilization of any plot reserved for the purpose mentioned in sub-section (1), apply to the Commissioner for conversion of such plot to any other purpose.

(3) The Commissioner shall, on receipt of an application under sub-

section (2), invite objections from the general public through a notice published in one English and one vernacular leading local daily newspaper and the objections, if any, shall be submitted to the Commissioner within 30 days from the date of the publication of the notice.

(4) The Commissioner shall, after considering the objections received under sub-section (3) and hearing such persons as he may consider necessary forward his recommendations along with the application and other connected papers to Government for orders".

Explanation.— The provisions of clause (2), (3) and (4) shall also apply to existing schemes.
