

SIND ORDINANCE NO.II OF 1978
THE SIND LAND REVENUE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1978

[2nd February, 1978]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Land Revenue Act, 1967, and to provide for assessment and recovery of land revenue from Rabi 1976-77.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Land Revenue Act, 1967, and to provide for assessment and recovery of land revenue from Rabi 1976-77, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Land Revenue (Amendment) Ordinance, 1978.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Land Revenue Act, 1967, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 56-A—

Amendment of section 56-A of West Pakistan Act XVII of 1967.

(i) in clause (a), for the word “twelve”, the word “twenty-five” shall be substituted;

(ii) in clause (b), for the word “twenty-five”, the word “fifty” shall be substituted.

(iii) In clause (c), for the word “twelve”, the word “twenty-five” shall be substituted.

3. In the said Act, in section 70-A, in the table, in column 3—

Amendment of section 70-A of West Pakistan Act XVII of 1967.

(i) for figures “150”, the words “three hundred” shall be substituted; and

(ii) for the figures “200”, the words “four-hundred” shall be substituted.

4. The Sind Abolition of Land Revenue and Agricultural Income Tax Act, 1977 (Sind Act VIII of 1977) is hereby repealed, and land revenue shall be assessed and recovered as if that Act had never been enacted. **Repeal and revival of land revenue.**
