

**SIND ORDINANCE NO. XVI OF 1979**

**THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1979**

[10<sup>th</sup> September, 1979]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**Preamble.**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1979.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 37-A, after sub-section (2), the following shall be added:-

**Amendment of section 37-A of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.**

“(3) The Election Authority may require any Judicial Officer of the rank of a District Judge or Additional District Judge to conduct an enquiry under sub-section (2) and pass such orders as he deems fit.”
