

SIND ORDINANCE NO. V OF 1984

THE SIND NATIONAL CALAMITIES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[27TH August, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the Sind National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in Pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind National Calamities (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958, in section 8, after sub-section (2), the following shall be added as sub-section (3) :— **Amendment of section 8 of West Pakistan Act, XXXIII of 1958.**

“(3) No order in revision under sub-section (1) shall be passed unless the person likely to be affected thereby is afforded an opportunity of being heard.”.
