

**SIND ORDINANCE NO. VII OF 1984.**

**THE REFORMATORY SCHOOLS (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[3<sup>rd</sup> September, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897;

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Reformatory Schools (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897, in its application to the Province of Sind, in section 17, in sub-section (2), the comma and the words "of whom two at least shall be citizens of Pakistan" shall be deleted.

**Amendment of section 17 of Act VIII of 1897.**
