

SIND ORDINANCE NO. VIII OF 1984.

THE SIND RELIEF OF INDEBTEDNESS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[3RD September, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Relief of Indebtedness Ordinance, 1960.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Relief Of Indebtedness Ordinance, 1960;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Relief of Indebtedness Ordinance, 1960, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called The Sind Relief of Indebtedness (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Relief of Indebtedness Ordinance, 1960, for section 8, the following shall be substituted :—

Amendment of section 8 of West Pakistan Ordinance XV of 1960.

“8. Exemption of milk animals, etc., from attachment or sale.”

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, milk animals, whether in milk or in calf, kids, calves, animals used for the purpose of transport or draught and carts shall not, if they belong to and are necessary for the maintenance of a debtor or his family, be liable to attachment or sale in execution of any decree.”.
