

**SIND ORDINANCE NO.XVIII OF 1984**

**THE SIND PRIVATE COLLEGES (MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[27<sup>th</sup> September, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) Ordinance, 1970.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the law relating to management and control of private colleges:

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) Ordinance, 1970, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Private Colleges (Management and Control) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind private Colleges (Management and Control) Ordinance, 1970, in section 5, after sub-section (1), the following new sub-section shall be inserted: —

**Amendment of Section 5 of Sind Ordinance X of 1970.**

“(1-A) The Chairman or a member may be removed from office for such reasons and in such manner as may be prescribed:

Provided that no order of removal shall be passed unless the Chairman or member, as the case may be, is given an opportunity of being heard.”.
