

**SIND ORDINANCE NO.XXVI OF 1984**

**THE POLICE (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[30<sup>th</sup> September, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Police Act, 1861, in its application to the Province of Sind.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Police Act, 1861; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Police Act, 1861, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Police (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

**Short title and commencement**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Police Act, 1861, in its application to the Province of Sind, in section 15-A, in sub-section (2), for clause (b), the following shall be substituted:-

**Amendment of section 15-A of Act V of 1861.**

“(b) to fix the amount of compensation equal to the amount of diyat, ursh or daman, as the case may be, as payable under the Sharia, and to determine the persons to whom and the manner in which it is to be paid; and”.
