

## SIND ORDINANCE NO.XXXVII OF 1984

### THE SIND BUILDINGS CONTROL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[1<sup>st</sup> November, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sind Buildings Control Ordinance, 1979.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Buildings Control Ordinance, 1979;

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Buildings Control Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Buildings Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Buildings Control Ordinance, 1979, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 14, in sub-section (3), the fullstop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-

**Amendment of section 14 of Sind Ordinance V of 1979.**

“Provided that no action shall be taken under this section unless the person who is likely to be affected thereby is given an opportunity of being heard.”.

3. In the said Ordinance, in section 17, the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-

**Amendment of section 17 of Sind Ordinance V of 1979.**

“Provided that no application or appeal shall be disposed unless the applicant or appellant, as the case may be, is given an opportunity of being heard.”.
