

SIND ORDINANCE NO.XXXIX OF 1984

THE SIND BOARDS OF INTERMEDIATE AND SECONDARY EDUCATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[4th November, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 6 of the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972, the full-stop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:- **Amendment of section 6 of Sind Ordinance VI of 1972.**

“Provided that no member shall be removed unless he is given an opportunity of being heard.”.
