

SIND ORDINANCE NO.XLIII OF 1984

THE SINDH PUBLIC CONVEYANCES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[15th November, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Public Conveyances Act, 1920.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Public Conveyances, Act, 1920;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Public Conveyances Act, 1920, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Public Conveyances (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Public Conveyances Act, 1920, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 5, in sub-section (2), the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-

Amendment of section 5 of Sind Act VII of 1920.

“Provided that no order shall be passed under the foregoing sub-sections unless the person likely to be affected thereby is given an opportunity of being heard.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 10, in sub-section (1), the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-

Amendment of section 10 of Sind Act VII of 1920.

“Provided that no order shall be passed unless the person likely to be affected thereby is given an opportunity of being heard.”.

4. In the said Act, in section 12, after sub-section (2), the following new sub-section (3) shall be added:-

**Amendment of
section 12 of Sind
Act VII of 1920**

“(3) Before any order is made by the Superintendent under this section, the person likely to be affected thereby shall be given an opportunity of being heard.”.
