

## SIND ORDINANCE NO. XLVI of 1984

### THE SIND SPORTS BOARD (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[18<sup>th</sup> November, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Sports Board Ordinance, 1980.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendment in the Sind Sports Board Ordinance, 1980; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Sports Board Ordinance, 1980, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Sports Board (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. **Short title, commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Sports Board Ordinance, 1980, in section 5, the full-stop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-- **Amendment of section 5 of Sind Ordinance VIII of 1980.**

“Provided that no order of removal shall be passed unless the member concerned has been given an opportunity of showing cause and being heard.”.
