

SIND ACT NO.VII OF 1985

THE STAMP (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1985

[16th December, 1985]

An Act to amend the Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Stamp (Sind Amendment) Act, 1985.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the Province of Sind, in Section 2, after clause (22), the following new clauses shall be inserted: —

Amendment of section 2 of Act II of 1899.

“(22-A) ‘public office’ includes a Government Office, Office of a Local Council, a Local Authority, a statutory corporation or a similar body set up by the Federal or Provincial Government or a commercial or industrial concern, whether singly owned or run through partnership having more than twenty employees, a body registered under the Company Law for the time being in force or a co-operative society;

(22-B) ‘public officer’ includes an Officer-in-charge of a public office.”
