

SINDH ACT NO.III OF 1991

THE SINDH MINISTERS (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1991

[5th June, 1991]

An Act to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows: —

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1991.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 6-A, for sub-section (1) the following shall be substituted:-

Amendment of section 6-A of Sind Act, VIII of 1975.

“(1) A Minister may in his discretion make grants to the extent of one hundred thousand rupees in a year.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 10, in sub-section (1), for the words “one hundred and twenty five rupees”, the words “one hundred and fifty rupees” shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 10 of Sind Act, VIII of 1975.

4. In the said Act, after section 13, the following new section shall be added:—

Insertion of section 10-A in Sind Act, VIII of 1975.

“13-A. Where a Minister, while travelling on duty outside the Province, stays in a hotel, guest-house, inspection bungalow, lodge or a residential club shall, in addition to the daily allowance admissible under section 10, be entitled to the reimbursement of the actual single room rent not exceeding three times of the daily allowance, per day, on production of receipts/vouchers.”.

Payment of actual expenses.
