THE SINDH CIVIL SERVANTS (REGULARIZATION OF ADHOC APPOINTMENTS) ACT, 1994.

[28th July, 1994]

An Act to provide for regularization of the services of certain civil servants appointed on adhoc basis.

WHEREAS it is expedient in the public interest to provide for regularization of the services of certain civil servants appointed on adhoc basis in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Civil Servants (Regularization of Adhoc Appointments) Act, 1994.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

Definitions.

(a) "Act" means the Sindh Civil Servants Act 1973;

(b) "Commission" means the Sindh Public Service Commission;

(c) "Government" means the Government of Sindh; and

(d) "post" means a post sanctioned by Government connected with the affairs of the Province.

(2) The expressions "adhoc appointment" and "civil servant" shall have the same meaning as respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or rules thereunder, or in any decree, order or judgment of a court, but subject to other provisions of this Act a civil servant holding adhoc appointment against a post in BS-16 or above and is in employment on the commencement of this Act, shall, on orders made in that behalf, be deemed to have been validly appointed to that post on regular basis with effect from the date of the commencement of this Act.

(2) The orders under sub-section (1) shall not be made unless antecedents of such civil servants, his academic qualifications, experience, age and place of domicile are scrutinized and cleared by a Special Committee appointed by Government.

(3) The Special committee under sub-section (2) shall be headed by the Secretary incharge of the Department concerned and amongst others shall consist of a representative each from that Department and the Services and General Administration Department.

4. Where the Commission, has recommended any person for appointment to a post in a cadre or service before the commencement of this Act such person may be accommodated.
