

THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1994.

[12TH October, 1994]

AN ACT to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Local Government (Second Amendment) Act, 1994. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 16, after sub-section (2), the following sub-section shall be added :— [Amendment of section 16 of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.](#)

“(3) Where any person or authority is appointed under sub-section (2), Government may appoint an Advisory Council consisting of such number of persons as it thinks fit to perform such functions as Government may by notification assign to it.

(4) The Advisory Council shall meet as often and in such manner as such person of Authority deems fit.

(5) A member of the Advisory Council shall hold office at the pleasure of Government but may at any time resign from membership by addressing letter to Government.

(6) The person or authority appointed under the proviso to sub-section (2) shall appoint a member of the Advisory Council, or where no such Council is appointed such person or authority may appoint any other person, to exercise the powers and perform the functions of the Chairman of a Panchayat.”

3. The Sindh Local Government (Sindh Amendment) Ordinance, 1994 is hereby repealed. **Repeal**
